ORDER

(Date of Order: 14.12.2018)

1. In the instant petition the Commission vide Order dated 02.11.2018 had approved levelised tariff of Rs. 3.66 per unit for sale of power to the DISCOMs of Delhi. The Petitioner M/s East Delhi Waste Processing Company Ltd. (EDWPCL) has already executed a PPA with BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. For purchase of 49% of total generated power from its Waste to Energy project. It was further directed that the Respondent DISCOMs, who have already procured power from the project from the date of commercial operation (COD) were required to clear the pending bills at a tariff of Rs. 3.66 per unit as per the due procedure.
2. In terms of the abovementioned Order and to regularize the past energy procured by BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. (BRPL) from the aforesaid project during the period from 28.04.2017 to 31.12.2018, M/s BRPL has submitted a copy of the PPA dated 26th November, 2018 signed between BRPL and EDWPCL for approval of the Commission.
3. The terms of PPA have been examined and it is observed that with effect from 01.01.2019, the seller (EDWPCL) intends to sell remaining 51% share of power under open access route to third party consumers other than Delhi DISCOMs and so going forward the seller would not sell 51% of its remaining power to Delhi DISCOMs, which justifies the short term of the PPA i.e. upto 31.12.2018 to regularise past procurement by BRPL.
4. The PPA after examination has been found to be in order and accordingly the Commission accords approval to the PPA.
