Record of Proceedings

1. Heard the Learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner, Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD). The present Petition pertains to a project initiated by MCD for generation of electricity from municipal solid waste. The Petitioner has sought adoption of the tariff discovered through the competitive bidding process in accordance with the applicable guidelines. The Petitioner has also prayed for approval of the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with the Distribution Licensees (Discoms).
2. The Commission observes that, under the extant policy and regulatory provisions governing Waste-to-Energy projects, the Distribution Licensees are obligated to procure power generated from such projects. However, the allocation of power

among the Discoms would require deliberations with the concerned Distribution Licensees and decision on allocation among them. It is noted that all the Discoms have been impleaded as parties to the present proceedings.

3. Accordingly, the Petition is admitted. Notice is issued to all the Respondent Discoms. The Respondents shall file their replies/objections, if any, within three (3) weeks from the date of issuance of notice, with an advance copy to the Petitioner. The Petitioner may file its rejoinder, if any, thereafter.
4. List the matter for further hearing immediately after the expiry of the aforesaid period of three weeks.
