1. Heard Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner. The present Petition has been filed seeking determination of tariff under Section 62 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for the additional capacity of 18 MW of the Waste-to-Energy (WTE) Plant and approval of the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) proposed to be executed with the Distribution Licensees (Discoms).
2. It is submitted on behalf of the Petitioner that any further information or clarification, if required by the Commission for the purpose of tariff determination, shall be furnished expeditiously. Replies have already been filed by BRPL and BYPL. TPDDL has also filed its response but has sought liberty to place additional submissions/affidavit on record, if considered necessary.

3. Accordingly, TPDDL is granted one week's time to file additional affidavit, if it so desires.
4. The Learned Counsel for MCD is supporting this Petition in the legislative interest of the environmental protection through Solid Waste Management and disposal.
5. The Commission shall examine the pleadings, replies, objections and comments filed by the Discoms, along with the rejoinder, if any, filed by the Petitioner. Upon completion of such examination and consideration of the material available on record, the Commission shall proceed with the determination of tariff under Section 62 of the Act and thereafter consider the approval of the draft PPA.
6. The allocation of additional capacity of power from the WTE Project amongst the Discoms shall also be considered after due consultation with Discoms.
