ORDER

1. The Appellate Tribunal for Electricity vide its order dated 10.04.2012 in Appeal No. 194, 195 & 196 of 2011 in the matter of DJB Vs. DERC & others. remanded the matter regarding parity of tariff of DJB with Industrial tariff for consideration. Further, the State Commission is directed to pass the consequential order within 90 days of the date of this judgement.
2. The Commission in compliance of the above direction of the ATE issued a notice dated 08.06.2012 to the concerned parties for hearing on 19.06.2012.
3. Mr. Suresh Tripathi, Ld. Counsel for Delhi Jal Board made a request to reconsider the Tariff of the Delhi Jal Board and parity of its tariff with Industrial tariff.
4. Ld. Counsel for NDPL submitted that he did not get a copy of the application filed on behalf of Delhi Jal Board.
5. The Commission directs Delhi Jal Board to provide a copy of its application to the NDPL today itself.
6. The Commission further directs NDPL to file its reply with a week (i.e. 26.06.2012) with an advance copy to Delhi Jal Board.
