## **ORDER**

(Date of Hearing: 19.06.2012) (Date of Order: 06.07.2012)

- 1. The Appellate Tribunal for Electricity vide its order dated 10.04.2012 in Appeal No. 194, 195 & 196 of 2011 in the matter of DJB Vs. DERC & othrs. remanded the matter regarding parity of tariff of DJB with Industrial tariff for consideration of the Commission. Further, the State Commission was directed to pass the consequential order within 90 days of the date of this judgement.
- 2. The Commission in compliance of the above direction of the ATE issued a notice dated 08.06.2012 to the concerned parties for hearing on 19.06.2012.
- 3. Mr. Suresh Tripathi, Ld. Counsel for Delhi Jal Board advanced arguments for reconsideration of the Tariff of Delhi Jal Board and parity of this tariff with industrial tariff. Ld. Counsel for BRPL & BYPL and Mr. Anurag Bansal, Sr. Manager, TPDDL also advanced their arguments.
- 4. The Commission heard the arguments made on behalf of Delhi Jal Board BRPL BYPL and NDPL at length. The Commission perused the application filed on behalf of the Delhi Jal Board pursuant to the judgement dated 10.04.2012 of the ATE and the replies filed by BRPL, BYPL & NDPL. The Commission also perused the order of ATE dated 10.04.2012.
- 5. The Commission has reconsidered the issue of parity of DJB tariff with industrial tariff and accordingly revised the tariff of Delhi Jal Board as per the Commission's order dated 26.06.2012 which is effective from 01.07.2012 and shall be as mentioned below:-
