**ORDER**

1. Heard the Counsel for the Respondent. This petition has been filed u/s 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003, and the main grievance of the Petitioner is that there have been violations of the Regulations and therefore the Petition would be maintainable u/s 142. However, it is to be noted that the Petitioner has arrived at a settlement with the Respondent before the Permanent Lok Adalat. The terms of the settlement before the Lok Adalat are reproduced herein as under:

*“(v) It is agreed that in view of the settlement arrived at consumer shall not file any proceeding against BYPL in respect of the present bill before any Court of Law/ Forum/ Commission and withdraw all cases pending in any Court of Law/Forum/Commission in respect of settled bill and BYPL shall not file any criminal complaint under Electricity Act, 2003 and shall withdraw the complaint, if already filed before Special Court of Electricity on receiving entire payment of the settlement amount.”*

2. Looking into the terms and conditions of settlement as agreed between the parties, the Commission is of the view that the Petition u/s 142 is not maintainable. It is accordingly dismissed.
