### **INTERIM ORDER**

(Date of Hearing: 14.07.2016) (Date of Order: 26.07.2016)

 The instant petition has been filed by Shri. Ashok Kumar under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure laid down in the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007. 2. The matter was listed for hearing in the Commission today, which was attended by both the parties. During the hearing, the Counsel for the Respondent submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and a copy of the settlement letter has already been furnished to

the Commission.

report before the Commission within two weeks. The matter was adjourned.
