**ORDER**

(Date of Order: 06.07-2016)

1. Whereas, the provisions for review of sanctioned load/contract demand by the DISCOMs on the basis of Maximum Demand Indicator (MDI) have been made vide the third amendment to the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. Whereas, the DISCOMs have reported difficulty in implementation of the aforesaid provisions stating the reason that since major changes in the existing policy for revision of sanctioned load based on MDI have been notified, it would be difficult to make effective implementation of these provisions by 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2016
3. Now, therefore, in order to remove difficulty in implementation of provisions of the Regulations, the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission in exercise of its power conferred under Regulation 70(ii) of the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007 hereby make the order that for the first time, the notice for upward/downward revision of sanctioned load or contract demand may be issued by 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2016. However, the effective date for upward/downward revision shall be 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2016.
