**ORDER** 

(Date of Order: 01.06.2017)

1. Whereas, the Commission has issued Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission

(Terms and Conditions for open Access) Regulations, 2005, wherein the

Commission has specified the timeline for consent/NOC of Open Access to the

Open Access applicants. It also stipulates incorporation of schedule in case of

contingency beyond working days.

2. State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC) Delhi, during a meeting in the office of

DERC in respect of Draft Open Access order, has raised the issues regarding

processing of applications for incorporation of schedule and has informed that

SLDC does not have sufficient infrastructure including round the clock man

power to revise schedule to incorporate contingent Open Access transactions

beyond working days and therefore, these applications can be handled on

working days only.

3. The Commission has considered the submission made by SLDC and has observed

that application for incorporation of schedule by Open Access Consumers

should not be withheld for want of man power. The Commission directs SLDC to

develop necessary infrastructure including round the clock man power, within six

months, for revising schedule to incorporate contingent Open Access

transactions.
