### <u>ORDER</u>

- The instant petition has been filed by Shri Devender Singh under Section 142
  of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. for violation of
  the procedure laid down of the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and
  Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
- 2. Notice of the petition was issued on 17.08.2015 to Respondent to file its reply.

- 3. In response to the above notice, the Respondent filed its reply on 05.11.2015 and has denied all allegations and sought dismissal of the complaint.
- 4. Subsequently, on 26.11.2015, the Commission received a letter dated 13.11.2015 from the Complainant's wife forwarding thereby a copy of death certificate of her husband Shri Devender Singh, the complainant and she also intimated that an amicable settlement has arrived at between the parties and prayed that the Commission may be pleased to close/dispose off the complaint as settled between the petitioner and the respondent.
- 5. The matter was listed for hearing in the Commission on 03.12.2015, which was attended by the Respondent, however, no appearance was made from the petitioner side. The counsel of the respondent requested to dismiss the petition as per the aforesaid terms of settlement.
- 6. In view of the facts stated above, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
