ORDER

(Date of Order: 01.10.2025)

1. The instant Petition has been filed by Tata Power Delhi Distribution Ltd. (TPDDL)/Petitioner for seeking *in principle* approval of the Bidding documents of Design, Supply, Testing, Installation, Commissioning, Operation and Maintenance of proposed Project being 50MW/100MWh Standalone & Grid Connected Battery Energy Storage Systems under Tariff based Competitive Bidding for meeting peak demand and optimization of power procurement cost, *inter-alia* praying for the following: -
 - a. To accord *in-principle* approval for Design, supply, Testing, Installation, Commissioning, Operation and Maintenance of Projects of 50MW/100MWh Standalone & grid-connected Battery Energy Storage Systems.
 - b. To accord approval of the draft RfS and draft BESSA along with certain deviations for Design, Supply, Testing, Installation, Commissioning, Operation and Maintenance of Projects of 50MW/100MWh Standalone & grid connected Battery Energy Storage Systems;

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner states that the Petitioner vide its letter dated 22.08.2025 has sought permission of the Commission to withdraw the instant Petition with liberty to approach the Commission in future. The prayer of the Petitioner for withdrawal of the instant Petition is allowed.
