INTERIM ORDER

- 1. Heard Sh. Buddy A. Ranganadhan. He has with clarity argued before this Commission that a rebate due to the Corona Pandemic was allowed by the Central Government through NTPC. The amount of rebate given by the NTPC is Rs. 41.37 Crore. However, the DERC has allowed a rebate of Rs. 71.30 Crore. The Officers of the Commission have pointed out that they were in receipt of a letter directly from the Central Government through Delhi Government prescribing a rebate of Rs. 71.30 Crore. The DERC has acted in good faith according to the official communication received by them through the respective Governments. It will be in the fitness of the things that a reply to the Petition along with the aforesaid letter may be filed in the case after giving a copy to Mr. Buddy A. Ranganadhan in advance.
- 2. It has also been pointed out by the officers that in any case this figure can be corrected when the true up petition comes up later on. Be that as it may, a reply to the case filed by Mr. Buddy A. Ranganadhan should be filed.
