(Date of Hearing: 04.09.2018) (Date of Order: 11.09.2018)

- The Counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted that various issues raised by the Respondent have been reconciled and accepted by the Petitioner. Further, it was argued that the pre-conditions of 72 hours of continuous running of plant prior to its commissioning is not practically feasible for MSW Plants and therefore may not be made applicable in the instant case.
