1. The Counsel for the Petitioner on the earlier occasion informed the Commission that in Appeal no. 297 of 2015 the applicant has withdrawn the issue no. 60 before the Appellant Tribunal. The said application has been allowed vide Order dated 12.11.2018 and the Appellate Court has given liberty to the Petitioner i.e. BRPL to address the issue before the Commission. The said order is taken on record.
2. Similar Order have been passed in Appeal No. 290 of 2015 in respect of issue No. 37a and issue no. 60; in Appeal No. 265 of 2013 in respect of issue No. 24(g) and in Appeal No. 236 of 2014 in respect of issue No. 32(b) giving same liberty to the Petitioner. It is stated on behalf of the Petitioner that in respect of two other Appeals similar applications have been moved and it is expected that very shortly in respect of these appeals also similar Order would be passed.

3. Since all the issues involve common question of law and impact, therefore it would be appropriate for the counsel of the Petitioner to get their application disposed of and then to list matters for arguments.
