The Respondent SECI filed an appeal against the Commission's Order dated 31.12.2020 before the APTEL wherein vide Order dated 02.07.2021 Hon'ble APTEL restored the Trading Margin of 7paise. The present Petition is being filed to implement the Order of the APTEL and to enter into a supplementary PSA in this regard.
