**INTERIM ORDER**

(Date of Hearing: 23.01.2018)

(Date of Order: 30.01.2018)

1. Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submitted that the present petitions have been filed by the Petitioners viz. BRPL and BYPL with the prayer to treat the loss on retirement of assets as per the petitioners books of accounts and allow the same as a pass-through in the next Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) of the petitioners along with applicable carrying cost. It was further submitted by the Counsel for the Petitioners that if profit on retirement of assets is accounted for in the ARR of the Petitioners the corresponding expenditure may also be taken into consideration.

2. On this issue the Commission observes that the DERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff) Regulations, 2017 has since been notified, which provides for methodology for treatment of loss and profit on retirement of assets; and the same treatment may be given to the assets retired during the period for which the instant petitions have been filed.
3. At the request of the Counsel for the Petitioners seeking time to get instructions from the Petitioners, two weeks time is granted to file reply on the aforesaid issue. The matter is adjourned.
4. The next date of hearing will be informed in due course.
