INTERIM ORDER

(Date of Hearing: 18.05.2023) (Date of Order: 18.05.2023)

- 1. Heard, Mr. Anand Srivastava, Counsel for the Petitioner. He has submitted that apart from the present Petition, two more Petitions regarding PPAC of Quarter-2 and Quarter-3 are pending for approval before the Commission. It has been brought to the notice that the Commission vide its Order dated 16.03.2023 has extended PPAC up to 30.06.2023 and considered the above-mentioned Petitions by the said Order. However, Mr. Srivastava has pointed out that there are no specific orders with respect to the Petitions of PPAC for Q2 and Q3.
- 2. Further, he has submitted that the present case is fit for exercising 'Power to Relax' by the Commission for allowance to levy legitimate average PPAC at 32.41% for three quarters i.e. Quarter-1, Quarter-2 and Quarter-3 or till further orders of the Commission, whichever is later. Mr. Srivastava has also submitted that all the relevant data related to his claim has already been filed and if any need arises, he is ready to provide further assistance to the Officers of the Commission.
- 3. Admit the Petition. Order is reserved.
