### **INTERIM ORDER**

(Date of Hearing: 22.02.2018) (Date of Order: 28.02.2018)

- The instant petition has been filed by Mohd. Isa, under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure as laid down in Regulations of the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
- 2. The Authorized Representative of the Petitioner submitted that the average recorded consumption pattern in the present is found to be 81.91% of the assessed consumption and in such circumstances, as per the extant regulations no case of DAE can be made out, however the Respondent has booked him for a theft case violating the provisions of Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

- 3. The Counsel for the Respondent rebutted that as per the revised speaking Order the average Consumption was recorded as 39.91%.
- 4. Keeping in view the aforesaid, both the parties are directed to meet on 27.02.2018 (Afternoon) in the office of the Respondent, to reconcile the bills/details of reading etc. before placing their arguments in the matter.
- 5. The matter is adjourned. The next date of hearing shall be intimated to the parties in due course.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
