ORDER

1. The instant petition has been filed by Sh. Krishan Kant Singh, under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure laid down in Regulations of the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. The Commission while admitting the above petition, vide its Interim Order dated 25.08.2015, directed the Respondent to show cause on the prima

facie findings of violations of Regulations 52 (viii) read with Regulation 38 (c), 52(ix) and 52(x) of Delhi Electricity Supply Code & Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

3. In the meantime, the respondent has submitted its reply dated 13.11.2015 in response to our Show Cause notice dated 25.08.2015.
4. The matter was listed for hearing today. No appearance was made by the petitioner or his counsel. The counsel of the Respondent submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and requested to dismiss the petition.
5. A letter dated 18.05.2016 from the petitioner was also received in the Commission, wherein it is stated that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties under OTSS (one time settlement scheme) and the complainant has no grievance against the respondent and the complainant wants to withdraw the present complaint.
6. In view of the facts stated above, the request of the petitioner to withdraw the case is acceded to and accordingly the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
7. Ordered accordingly.
