 The instant case relates to Suo moto cognizance been taken by the Commission under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against the Licensee namely BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure laid down in the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. on 16.03.2017, the Commission granted two

days time to the Licensee to respond on the issue raised by the complainant.

However, the Licensee has failed to do so.

3. The matter was heard on 27.04.2017, which was attended by the

Counsel/authorized representatives of Licensee. The Counsel on behalf of the

Complainant was also present.

4. The Counsel appearing on behalf of the Licensee sought four weeks time on

the ground that vigilance enquiry has been initiated against the concerned

official of BRPL who was involved in wrong doing at the premise of the

complainant.

5. The Commission accepted the prayer of the Licensee and granted last

opportunity to the Licensee to file a status report along with a written

submission especially in respect of harassment meted out to the consumer

within four weeks time. The matter was adjourned.

6. The next date of hearing shall be intimated to the parties in due course.

7. Ordered accordingly.
