ORDER

The instant petition has been filed by Smt. Meena Rawat, under Section 142
of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of
the procedure laid down in the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and
Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

2. The matter was listed for hearing in the Commission, wherein both the parties

were present. During the hearing the counsel for the Respondent contended

that the present Petition is not maintainable since the Petitioner has entered

into a settlement with the Respondent, which has also been executed. As per

the terms of settlement both the parties have to withdraw all the litigations

pending in various courts of law/fora and therefore, the Respondent has not

filed the case before the Special Court of Electricity. He further submitted

that as per the terms of settlement the Petitioner may not prefer the instant

Petition. Accordingly, the present Petition is not maintainable.

3. The counsel for the Petitioner submitted that he has entered into a settlement

under protest because he is posted in far-flung area in Manipur and thus had

no option but to settle the matter.

4. The Commission observed that as per the terms of settlement, the Petitioner is

required to withdraw the instant Petition and thus the present Petition is not

maintainable. However, keeping in view the nature and seriousness of

violations, the Commission takes suo motu cognizance of the violations and

directed that fresh notice be issued in the matter.

5. Thus, the present petition is disposed off. Ordered accordingly.
