### **ORDER**

(Date of Order: 21.01.2016)

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner, Ms. Mona Bhatnagar, under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against Tata Power Delhi Distribution Ltd. for violation of certain procedures as contained in Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. Notice of the petition was issued to the respondent on 27.11.2015 to file its reply.
3. In the meantime, the respondent vide its letter No. TPDDL/Regulatory/110 dated 03.12.2015 submitted that the proceedings for theft of Electricity initiated on the basis of aforesaid inspection has already been dropped and the case is closed and normal assessment to be charged as per rule.

4. An email dated 31.12.2015 has also been received from the Counsel of the petitioner intimating thereby that the Respondent, TPDDL has dropped the DAE charges and the Petitioner wants to withdraw the present complaint.
5. Subsequently, the Respondent vide its letter No. TPDDL Letter No. TPDDL/REGULATORY/110 dated 13.01.2016 has also provided a copy of application dated 03.12.2015 by the Counsel of the petitioner, whereby permission of the Commission has been sought for withdrawal of the petition in view of the settlement of the dispute in respect of the captioned matter. A copy of Memorandum of Settlement has also been furnished.
6. In view of the facts stated above, the request of the parties to close the case is acceded to and accordingly the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
