ORDER

(Date of Order: 11.04.2016)

1. The instant petition has been filed by Smt. Rajni Pasi under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure laid down in the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. The Commission while admitting the above petition, vide its Interim Order dated 20.01.2016, directed the Respondent to show cause on the prima facie findings of violations of Regulations 52 (vii) read with Regulation 38(C), 52(x), 52(xii) and 53(ii) of Delhi Electricity Supply Code & Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

3. Subsequently, vide its letter No. BRPL/CCG/2277 dated 04.02.2016, the Respondent submitted that the aforesaid dispute has been settled amicably between both the parties under OTSS (one time settlement scheme) on 13.01.2016, as per the request dated 13.01.2016 by the complainant for settlement of case under one time settlement scheme and the matter stands closed in their records.
4. On 10.03.2016, the Commission also received a letter dated 10.03.2016 from the Complainant's Advocate intimating thereby that in view of the settlement of the dispute between both the parties in respect of the captioned matter, the complainant wants to withdraw the present complaint.
5. In view of the facts stated above, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
