**ORDER**

(Date of Order: 06.12.2016)

1. The instant petition has been filed by M/s S.A. Salons through its partner, Ms Anjana Nagpal under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against Tata Power Delhi Distribution Ltd. for violation of the procedure regarding booking of theft case as laid down in the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. Subsequently, the Commission received a letter dated 17.11.2016 from the Respondent stating that the case has been resolved and the petitioner has no grievance with the matter in dispute.
3. The Commission has also received an application dated 07.11.2016 from the Petitioner for withdrawal of the aforesaid petition stating that the dispute for which she had filed the present complaint stands settled and therefore she
