ORDER

(Date of Order: 30/09/2022)

1. Representations have been received from NDMC wherein they have submitted their PPAC for Q4 FY 2021-22 & Q1 FY 2022-23 as 38.74% & 75.18%, respectively. However, NDMC is levying only 8.75% PPAC.
2. NDMC has 100 MW & 133 MW Power allocation from PPS-I Pragati & PPS-III Bawana, respectively for the above mentioned period. The steep increase in Gas prices over few months has impacted Energy Charge Rate (ECR) for these Gas based stations which has resulted into such high PPAC of NDMC.
3. In order to maintain 24x7 Power supply and enable NDMC to make timely payment, it has been decided that 22.18% PPAC on provisional basis be levied by NDMC w.e.f. 1/10/2022 till further Orders.
4. Ordered accordingly.
