1. One Mr. J.N. Mishra is present on behalf of the petitioner. He states that in view of the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the present petition. However, Mr. Mishra is unable to produce any authority on behalf of the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent has pointed out that on 01.08.2023 in W.P.(C) 8740/2016 titled 'BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. v. Neelam & Anr.', the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed the following order:

"3. After some hearing, learned counsel for the parties agree that the impugned order dated 28.05.2014 be set aside, and the respondent No. 1 may be directed to approach the Divisional Commissioner, Delhi, who is the prescribed authority to hear objections with regard to location of works under Rule 3 of the Works of Licensees Rules, 2006 made by the Central Government under Section 67(2) of the Electricity Act, 2003."

3. In view of above, nothing survives in the petition. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
