INTERIM ORDER

1. Heard Shri Anil Gupta, husband of Ms. Neha Goyal, who is Petitioner No. 1. Shri Anil Gupta is appearing in the capacity of a representative of his wife Ms. Neha Goyal and Petitioner No. 3, Ms. Usha Sharma. The other Petitioners Shri Anil Gupta & Raj Rani (Petitioner No. 2) are not present. It has been alleged that there were some violations of the Regulation of DERC (Supply Code & Performance Standards) Regulations, 2017. Shri Akhil Hasija, Counsel appearing for the Respondent, at the very outset has submitted that the matter has been settled at the National Lok Adalat on 21.08.2022. This fact has been denied by the Petitioners present before this Commission. It has been said that they never went to Lok Adalat rather they went to the office of the opposite party and under protest paid the bill, under threat of disconnection. There are two contradictions of facts.

2. Issue notice to the opposite party. Though Shri Akhil Hasija is present, a copy of the petition will be formally sent to the opposite party. List on 15.11.2022. Shri Akhil Hasija will be well advised to bring the award on record, as well as file his reply or other statements in his favour by the next date.
