- 1. Heard Mr. Buddy A. Ranganadhan, Counsel for the Petitioner. On the last occasion the question of maintainability was raised by the Commission to which Mr. Buddy A. Ranganadhan is ready to clarify. However, at the same time he has also submitted that his prayer can be better replied if the matter was to be taken up in the Tariff Proceedings. We feel that direction cannot be issued in this Petition to the Tariff Department rather the Commission will have to take up this matter and pass suitable orders in house. It will also be required that inputs from other DISCOMs/Stakeholders are also taken into account. For this purpose, we are disposing of this Petition with liberty to Mr. Buddy A. Ranganadhan or the Petitioner to move an application on the administrative side which can be taken up by the Commission to its logical end.
