<u>ORDER</u>

(Date of Order 27.03.2018)

- The Commission vide its Order dated 27.02.2014 had reallocated power from long term Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) to various DISCOMs supplying Power in National Territory of Delhi on the basis of average energy drawl for the period FY 2007-08 to 2011-12.
- 2. The reallocation of Power was further modified vide Tariff Orders dated 23.07.2014, 29.09.2015 and dated 31.08.2017.
- 3. The Commission has held rounds of Summer preparedness meetings which were attended by the representative of DISCOMs, DTL, GENCOs and SLDC. It is observed during the meetings that considering Delhi as a whole, there is power surplus during April '18 to Sept. '18, however, there is shortage of power in individual DISCOMs during few hours of certain fortnights.

- 4. In the meeting, DISCOMs have agreed to manage deficit of power in specific slots among themselves by trading through Inter DISCOM Transfer (IDT) and assured that there would not be shortage of power during summers of FY 2018-19 considering BTPS till July 2018.
- 5. TPDDL vide its letter dated. 12.01.2018 has submitted to SLDC that minor share allocation of up to 5 MW of Aravali Jhajjhar should be done from TPDDL to BRPL & BYPL and share of up to 5 MW from Dadri 1 & Dadri 2 should be allocated from BRPL & BYPL to TPDDL. This will ensure that all the DISCOMs have some allocation from Aravali Jhajjhar, Dadri 1 & Dadri 2 and in the event of contingency, individual DISCOM can schedule power from these stations as per the provisions of present Unscheduled Requisitioned Surplus (URS) Regulations. However, BRPL and BYPL have submitted to SLDC that there is no co-relation among Delhi DISCOMs and contingency as Delhi's allocation remains same.
- 6. However, SLDC has submitted that there should not be single beneficiary from Aravali Jhajjhar and Dadri Thermal Power Plant instead all the DISCOMs i.e., BRPL, BYPL and TPDDL should have reasonable share in these plants.
- 7. Proviso to regulation 121(4)of the DERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff) Regulations, 2017 enables the Commission in reassigning the allocation of power amongst the distribution licensees out of the overall power portfolio allocated to the National Capital Territory of Delhi by Ministry of Power, Government of India to adjust the gap in power purchase cost.
- 8. A meeting for the purpose of consultation with GoNCTD, SLDC, DTL and Distribution Licensees on the issue of re-allocation of power among Delhi DISCOMs was convened on 26.03.2018. Based on the discussions and comments/suggestions of stakeholders present during the meeting and in terms of proviso to regulation 121 (4) of the DERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff) Regulations, 2017, it is decided that:
 - With effect from 1/04/2018, 10 MW power from Aravali Jhajjhar shall be allocated to BRPL from BYPL and 10 MW each of Dadri-I and Dadri-II shall be allocated to TPDDL from BYPL.
 - 2. With effect from 1/04/2018, 100% share of BYPL (12 MW) from NPCIL-NAPS shall be allocated to BRPL.

- 3. With effect from 1/04/2018, 100% share of BYPL (25 MW) from Rihand I shall be allocated to BRPL.
- 4. For the period from May 2018 to October, 2018, 50% share of TPDDL from SASAN UMPP shall be allocated to BYPL and for the period from November, 2018 to March, 2019, 80% share of TPDDL from SASAN UMPP shall be allocated to BYPL.
- 9. Accordingly, the Re-allocation of Power for FY 2018-19 amongst Delhi DISCOMs for above mentioned Power Plants shall be as indicated in the table appended below:
