ORDER

(Dated of Order: 03.08.2010)

- 1. This Commission issued an Order dated 31.03.2007 introducing Intra-State ABT in Delhi w.e.f. 01.04.2007. Subsequently, Unscheduled Inter-Change charges were revised on 28.042007, 04.01.2008 and 21.04.2009 on account of change of UI charges by CERC. The CERC has again revised the Unscheduled Inter-Change charges by a notification dated 28.04.2010.
- 2. The Commission has examined the above notification of CERC, dated 28.04.2010. The Commission is of the view that there is a need to modify the UI charges for the Intra-State System of Delhi to be in line with the modification effected by CERC. Accordingly, the limits on over-drawal when frequency is below 49.7 Hz and under drawal by the beneficiaries shall be as follows:

3. All the above limits shall be applicable simultaneously and for the purpose of calculation of UI charges, additional UI charges and invoking of penal provisions as per the Act/Regulation/Orders/IEGC/State Grid Code, the over-drawal of electricity from the schedule by any utility during a time-block shall not exceed

12% of the scheduled drawal or demand in MW (whichever is lower) when frequency is below 49.7 Hz and 3% on daily aggregate basis. The under-drawal of electricity from the schedule by any utility during a time-block shall not be beyond 10% of the scheduled drawal or demand in MW (whichever is less) otherwise the UI charges receivable would be 403Ps/Unit and not 873Ps/Unit.

- 4(i). The provision of CERC Order dated 28.04.2010 for inter-state transaction would also be applicable to intra-state transactions with respect to under-drawal/over-drawal in Delhi even if Delhi as a whole is not over/under drawing.
- 4(ii). As regards generators and the Distribution Licensees, the conditions laid down above and in the CERC notification dated 28.04.2010 shall also be applicable besides the conditions stipulated by this Commission in its Order dated 31.03.2007.
- 5. The charges for UI, additional UI etc shall be paid to the Intra-State UI pool account maintained by SLDC and the payments from the pool account to the utilities shall be made by the SLDC in accordance with the procedure evolved in the meeting held in SLDC on 04.04.2007 as per directions at para 18(iii) of the Commission's Order dated 31.03.2007. Balance in the UI pool account shall be intimated to the Commission by the SLDC in the month of April of each financial year indicating the amounts available till the end of the previous financial year and the Commission shall issue necessary orders with regard to the utilization of such funds.
- 6. Other terms and conditions shall be in line with CERC notification dated 28.04.2010.
- 7. This Order shall come into force with effect from 03.05.2010 for zero sum accounting.
