ORDER

(Date of Hearing: 28.9.2006) (Date of Order: 17.10.2006)

- 1. The Complainant and the Respondent have submitted a copy of the mutual settlement agreement executed on 20.9.2006 before Sh. Prem Kumar, Conciliator in terms of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- 2. The gist of the mutual settlement is as under:
 - i) That the Respondent has agreed to drop the DAE case against the Complainant and the Complainant has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.4,25,000/- in full and final settlement of all claims. The Respondent shall have no claims, whatsoever, against the Complainant.

- ii) That the petitioner (Complainant) has agreed to pay the aforesaid amount by demand draft/cheque on or before 30.9.2006.
- iii) That the Respondent has agreed to restore electricity on payment of the cost of meter and restoration charges. New Billing shall start after restoration of electricity.
- iv) That the Respondent and Complainant have agreed that in the event of any default on behalf of the Complainant, in complying with clause 2 of the settlement herein, the Respondent shall be entitled to recover the entire amount of Rs.7,49,021/- forthwith alongwith LPSC till the date of payment and other charges.
- v) That both the parties have agreed that any case(s) pending before any court/quasi judicial authority/any other authority in respect of aforesaid case shall be withdrawn. Further, no party shall file any case before any Court/quasi judicial authority/any other authority, in relation to aforesaid DAE case and bill for recovery/damages/any other purpose etc.
- 3. In view of the mutual settlement between the parties, the matter is treated as amicably resolved and the complaint is disposed of accordingly.
- 4. Ordered accordingly.
