#### **INTERIM ORDER**

(Date of Hearing 21.04.2015) (Date of Order: 29.04.2015)

- The instant Petition has been filed by M/s BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. (BRPL) for dissolution of Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) dated 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2008, 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2009 and 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2012 entered into with Respondent No. 1, 2 and 3 viz. Aravali Power Co. Pvt. Ltd. (APCPL), Indraprastha Power Generation Co. Ltd. (IPGCL), Pragati Power Corporation Ltd. (PPCL), without any liability of fixed charges or damages on the Petitioner.
- 2. The matter came up for hearing for admission of the Petition.
- 3. The Counsel for the Petitioner argued at length and requested that dissolution of the aforesaid PPAs may be allowed as the power purchase through these PPAs is costlier and burdens the consumers.
- 4. However, as dissolution of PPA would result in reallocation of inter-se quota of power and a proposal on this issue was discussed during a recently held meeting of Delhi Power Procurement Group (DPPG) with State Load Dispatch Center (SLDC), which is under consideration. Therefore, it would be premature to hear the Petition at this stage.
- 5. Accordingly, the matter was adjourned.
- 6. The hearing for admission of the Petition will be listed in due course.
- 7. Ordered accordingly.
