ORDER

(Date of Hearing: 30.05.2014) (Date of Order: 30.05.2014)

- 1. Mr. Amit Kapur, Ld. Counsel for BRPL & BYPL filed an affidavit on 30.05.2014, the same is taken on record.
- 2. IPGCL, PPCL and DTL have also filed affidavits which are also taken on record.

- 3. The Commission heard Mr. Kapur, Ld. Counsel and representatives of IPGCL/PPCL, DTL, NTPC and THDCIL.
- 4. The Ld. Counsel for BRPL & BYPL submitted that REC has also sanctioned a loan amount of Rs. 250 crores each for BRPL and BYPL. He has further submitted that the sanctioned loan by REC and PFC is expected to be disbursed by 30.05.2014.
- 5. On the query of the Commission regarding the current outstanding dues payable to Gencos and Transcos till 31st May, 2014, the Ld. Counsel for BRPL and BYPL submitted that the current dues for BRPL shall be paid in full, however, in the case of BYPL there is a shortfall of Rs.153 Crores (approx.).
- 6. The Ld. Counsel further submitted that Commission may fix the hearing on 31.05.2014 for confirmation of payment of the current dues of Gencos and Transcos for the bills raised from 01.01.2014 in compliance with the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order dated 26.03.2014 & 06.05.2014.
- 7. The Commission has accepted the request of the Counsel and directs BRPL and BYPL to place on record an affidavit regarding actual payment of all current dues of Gencos and Transcos (including the shortfall of Rs. 153 crores (approx.) in the case of BYPL) in compliance with the Hon'ble Supreme Court's order dated 26.03.2014 & 06.05.2014.
- 8. The matter is listed for further hearing on 31.05.2014 at 3:00pm.
- 9. Ordered accordingly.
