INTERIM ORDER

(Date of Hearing: 26.09.2017) (Date of Order: 06.10.2017)

 Counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present petition is filed for clarification of the following two issues in respect of maintenance activity of streetlight poles: a) Non-payment of cost for material utilized towards street light maintenance; and

b) Non-payment of Service tax on street light maintenance by

MCD/PWD.

2. The Counsel for the petitioner also submitted that the maintenance

services provided by the petitioner towards the streetlight poles attracts

levy of service tax which is the liability of North MCD/PWD.

3. The Commission directed the petitioner to file an affidavit within a week

clearly mentioning whether the R&M Expenses towards maintenance of

the Streetlight were part of the total R&M expenses of the petitioner or not

for the corresponding period.

4. The matter is adjourned. The next date of hearing shall be informed to the

parties in due course.
