- 1. Ld. Counsel Mr. Mansih Srivastav, appearing for the Petitioner submitted that this Petition has been filed for adoption of Generic Tariff for Generation of Electricity from Grid Interactive Solar PV Project. He has further submitted that the direction of the Commission in its order dated 01.02.2013 that since no financial assistance is available for this project, therefore, Petitioner can approach the State Nodal Agency for REC registration/accredition for obtaining REC is perhaps not appropriate at this stage.
- 2. Ld. Counsel made a request that Commission may adopt Generic Tariff for this Solar PV Project according to the prayer made by the Petitioner.
- 3. Ld. Counsel further submitted that the Petitioner was granted liberty to file audited accounts for above Solar PV Project and details about the actual rate of interest on the monies borrowed by the Petitioner (loans & working capital) till date. The requisite information could not be placed before the Commission.

- 4. Ld. Counsel submitted that the Petitioner needs some more time to furnish the said information on an affidavit.
- 5. The Commission again granted liberty to file the requisite information on an Affidavit within two weeks.
- 6. The matter is listed for further hearing on 09.07.2013
- 7. Ordered accordingly.
