**INTERIM ORDER**

1. The instant petition has been filed by Sh. Devinder Khosla (Petitioner no.1) & Shri Tasrem Khosla (Petitioner no. 2) under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure regarding booking of theft case as laid down in Regulations of the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

2. The matter was listed for hearing in the Commission today, wherein both the parties were present. During the hearing, the Counsel for the Respondent submitted an application on the maintainability of the Petition. A copy of which was handed over to the Petitioner. The Commission directed the Petitioner to file a reply on the maintainability of the Petition within four weeks.
3. The Commission also observed that there are some discrepancies in the reply submitted by the Respondent with regards to the Meter number, etc. and directed the Respondent to furnish a revised reply after curing the defects within a week. The Petitioner may also file a rejoinder on the amended reply along with the reply on the application on maintainability of the petition.
4. The next date of hearing shall be intimated to the parties in due course.
