ORDER

1. In compliance with the Commission's earlier order dated 12.11.2012 Mr. M.K. Singh, Executive Engineer, PWD filed the information sought on an affidavit. The same is placed on the record.
2. Mr. Singh submitted that the solar plant at Thyagraj Stadium was commissioned on 6th April, 2010 and has started commercial production since then. The solar power so generated through this plant is being injected into the BRPL grid.
3. Mr. Singh further submitted that no subsidy was granted from MNRE for this Solar Power Project. The project accounts have already been audited by CAG including generation data and the accounts for solar power generation is being regularly sent to BRPL and DTL from the date of commissioning of this project.
4. Mr. Singh further submitted that though a power purchase agreement has been duly signed with BRPL, tariff rates have not been fixed. He has made a request to the Commission to fix the tariff rates for this solar power project.
5. The Commission considered the contention of the petitioner and directs that average power purchase cost determined by the Commission in its tariff orders from time to time for BRPL shall be the tariff rate for the solar power generated by the Petitioner from 1 MWp grid interactive solar power PV project. The Petitioner is free to separately sell the green component through the REC mechanism.
6. In response to the query of the Commission on the issue of 2.5 MW Gas Turbine Power Project, Mr. Singh submitted that the matter is under process to receive the required gas from the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas under the Administered Pricing Mechanism (APM Price) and this will take time.

7. In view of the above, the Commission is of the view that hearing in this petition on the 2.5MW gas turbine power project may be adjourned sine die with the direction to the Petitioner to request for further hearing after obtaining approval for the supply of gas from the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas under Administered Pricing Mechanism.
8. Ordered accordingly.
