1. Mr. M.G. Ramachandran, Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the Commission may determine the promotional Tariff for this project in accordance with the provisions of Section 86(1)(e) and Section 61(h) of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms & Conditions for Tariff Determination of Renewable Energy

Sources) Regulations, 2012 and DERC (Renewable Purchase Obligation and Renewable Energy Certificate Framework Implementation) Regulation 2011.

2. The Commission enquired about the applicability of the provisions referred to by the Learned Counsel keeping in view the competitive bidding undertaken for determination of tariff and award of the project on that basis to the developer. The Commission directs that the Counsel argue the matter regarding maintainability, in the light of the various provisions of the bid documents, EPA already entered into with the Purchaser and other provisions of law/regulations.
