ORDER

(Date of Hearing: 16.03.2012) (Date of Order: 23.03.2012)

- 1. Mr. Anurag Bansal, Sr. Manager (Legal), NDPL submitted that on perusal of the impugned review order dated 22.09.2009 it was noticed that certain errors have crept in the computations of amounts/figures of carrying cost allowed by the Hon'ble Commission in the said impugned review order.
- 2. Mr. Bansal further submitted that in the impugned order the Hon'ble Commission provided for an amount of Rs. 32.22 crore (respectively applying the rate of 9% p.a.) as approved Carrying Cost with respect to the True Ups for the F.Y. 2003-06.
- 3. Mr. Bansal further submitted that based on the computation made by the Petitioner applying said rate of 9% per annum as per the methodology adopted in the past Tariff Order on the amount given by the Hon'ble Commission for the True-Ups, it comes out Rs. 38.76 crore as against Rs. 32.22 crore, thereby resulting in an under-allowance of ARR by Rs. 6.54 crore.

- 4. Mr. Bansal requested for a technical deliberation session with the officials of the Commission to resolve the said issue.
- 5. The Commission accepted the request of the Petitioner and directs Executive Director (Engg/Tariff) to arrange a meeting with the officials of the NDPL to resolve the said issue within a week and submit its report to the Commission within two weeks.
- 6. The matter is listed for further hearing on 10.05.2012
- 7. Ordered accordingly.
