INTERIM ORDER

(Date of Hearing 29.05.2018) (Date of Order: 07.06.2018)

- The petitioner has filed the instant petition against the respondent alleging incorrect methodology adopted by respondent while preparing intra-state deviation settlement accounts and unlawfully retaining the UI Pool Accounts.
- 2. The Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the respondent has not filed the reply in the matter. It was further submitted that the present petition is a cross petition to petition No. 28 of 2018 filed by SLDC against BRPL and BYPL for Non compliance of the Commissions orders to pay current dues towards UI charges. Therefore, both the petitions may be tagged and heard together.
- 3. The petition is tagged with similar petition No. 28 of 2018.

- 4. The respondent is directed to file reply to the petition within three weeks, with an advance copy to the petitioner and the petitioner may file rejoinder, if any, within 2 weeks thereafter.
