INTERIM ORDER

(Date of Hearing 20.12.2017) (Date of Order: 28.12.2017)

- 1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 86 (1)(b) and other provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 for approval of bidding process, adoption of tariff of Municipal Waste to power plant and approval of draft PPA.
- The hearing was attended by the petitioners and the representative/counsels for TPDDL (Respondent No. 1), BRPL (Respondent No. 2) and BYPL (Respondent No. 4). However, no appearance was made on behalf of MES (Respondent No. 3), NDMC (Respondent No. 5), DTL (Respondent No. 6) and SLDC (Respondent No. 7).
- 3. The Counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the parties have held discussions and the DISCOMs 'in principal' agree to the tariff of the instant plant. However, some more consultation and meetings are required to finalise the terms of PPA. The Counsel for the Petitioner further submitted that keeping in view the above; the tariff of the plant may kindly be adopted by the Commission, which in turn will pave path for finalisation of PPA with the SPV (Tehkhand Waste to Electricity Project Limited) constituted for the purpose.
- 4. The Counsel for the Respondents namely BRPL and BYPL endorsed the submissions made by the Petitioner and submitted copies of the letters written by BRPL and BYPL to SDMC conveying that it is agreeable to them to procure such power at the proposed tariff of Rs. 5.129/unit.
- 5. The Counsel for TPDDL also agreed to the submissions made by the Petitioner as well as by the Counsel for BRPL and BYPL.
- 6. The Counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the documents namely the financial evaluation report signed by the bid evaluation committee and a

certificate on the conformity of the bidding process to the approved bidding document by the Evaluation Committee shall be furnished immediately.

- 7. The Petitioner has since submitted the aforesaid documents. On considering the submissions made by the Petitioner as well as on examination of the documents containing financial evaluation report and certificate on the conformity of the bidding process, the tariff of Rs. 5.129 per unit in respect of Tehkhand Waste to Electricity plant as determined through bidding process is adopted by the Commission.
- 8. The parties are directed to negotiate the terms of PPA and submit draft signed PPA within four weeks.
- 9. The next date of hearing will be informed in due course.
- 10. Ordered accordingly.
