2. The Commission heard the Ld. Counsel and decided that before admitting the Petition, the petitioner may make a detailed presentation on the next date of hearing to establish that the cost of peaking power from the pumped storage project of THDC Ltd. was uneconomic, unviable and not in the best interest of the consumers, and that they would be in a position to arrange peaking power from alternate sources at lower cost over the 35 year term of the PPA with THDC Ltd.
