PREFACE TO THE TRUE-UP ORDER FOR FY 2022-23

The Commission vide its Public Notice dated 3/12/2024 invited comments/suggestions from the stakeholders on the Petitions filed by Delhi Power Utilities (*namely, Indraprastha Power Generation Company Limited, Pragati Power Corporation Limited, Delhi Transco Limited, New Delhi Municipal Council, BSES Rajdhani Power Limited, BSES Yamuna Power Limited and Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited*). Thereafter, Public Hearing of True-up of FY 2022-23 was held on 27/03/2025. Accordingly, based on the comments/ suggestions from various stakeholders, the Commission after considering the applicable *DERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff) Regulations, 2017* and *DERC (Business Plan) Regulations, 2019* has issued the True-up Orders for FY 2022-23. The Regulatory Assets (RAs) of all four (4) DISCOMs amounting to a total of Rs. 2498.88 Crores (*including Carrying Cost*) which includes Rs. 1465.29 Crores of BRPL, Rs. 650.11 Crores of BYPL, Rs. 386.69 Crores of TPDDL & Surplus of Rs. 3.21 Crores of NDMC recognized during FY 2022-23. However, the impact of these RAs shall be given while liquidating the outstanding RA or in the Tariff Orders to be issued in future. Therefore, these True-up Orders shall not change the current Tariffs for above DISCOMs until the effect of the same is given in the ensuing Tariff Orders or at the time of liquidation of RAs.
