ORDER

1. The aforesaid review Petition is filed by M/s BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. in respect of the Order dated 21.06.2019 of this Commission in Petition No. 27 of 2019, wherein PPAC of 11.61% for the quarter Oct. 2018 to Dec. 2018 was approved to the Petitioner and it was decided that the Petitioner shall claim the differential PPAC of 6.87% (i.e 11.37%-4.50%) through ARR Petition for FY 2019-20 as the period of recovery of PPAC was already over.
2. The Petitioner has submitted that the Petitioner raised the claim for the differential PPAC in its ARR proceedings for the FY 2019-20, however, the same had not been subsumed in revised tariff for the FY 2019-20, therefore, Petitioner sought review of the Order dated 21.06.2019 to permit the Petitioner to recover the differential PPAC in the forthcoming months.
3. The contention of the Petitioner has been examined and it is observed that the aforesaid differential PPAC has not been subsumed in the tariff for the FY 2019-20. The Petitioner may be allowed to recover PPAC @ 3.435% in two quarters. Accordingly, the direction to claim PPAC through ARR as contained in para 3.iii of the aforesaid Order is modified and the Petitioner is directed to recover differential PPAC @ 3.435% (i.e. $\frac{1}{2} \times 6.87\%$) in two quarters i.e. 6 months."
4. Ordered accordingly.
