## **ORDER**

(Date of Hearing: 19.12.2019) (Date of Order: 18.02.2020)

- 1. The aforesaid review Petition is filed by M/s BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. in respect of the Order dated 21.06.2019 of this Commission in Petition No. 27 of 2019, wherein PPAC of 11.61% for the quarter Oct. 2018 to Dec. 2018 was approved to the Petitioner and it was decided that the Petitioner shall claim the differential PPAC of 6.87% (i.e 11.37%-4.50%) through ARR Petition for FY 2019-20 as the period of recovery of PPAC was already over.
- 2. The Petitioner has submitted that the Petitioner raised the claim for the differential PPAC in its ARR proceedings for the FY 2019-20, however, the same had not been subsumed in revised tariff for the FY 2019-20, therefore, Petitioner sought review of the Order dated 21.06.2019 to permit the Petitioner to recover the differential PPAC in the forthcoming months.
- 3. The contention of the Petitioner has been examined and it is observed that the aforesaid differential PPAC has not been subsumed in the tariff for the FY 2019-20. The Petitioner may be allowed to recover PPAC @ 3.435% in two quarters. Accordingly, the direction to claim PPAC through ARR as contained in para 3.iii of the aforesaid Order is modified and the Petitioner is directed to recover differential PPAC @ 3.435% (i.e. ½ x 6.87%) in two quarters i.e. 6 months."
- 4. Ordered accordingly.
