**ORDER**

(Date of Order: 29.07.2015)

1. The instant petition has been filed by Shri Radheshyam under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure laid down in the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. Notice of the petition was issued on 16.06.2015 to Respondent to file its reply.
3. Meanwhile, on 09.07.2015 the Commission received a letter dated 29.06.2015 from the Respondent intimating thereby that the aforesaid dispute has been settled amicably between the parties and No Dues clearance has been issued to the consumer after full and final payment of the settled amount and the matter stands closed in their records. The Respondent has also furnished a copy of an application dated 24.06.2015 from the petitioner, wherein the petitioner has submitted that the said matter has been amicably settled between both the parties. The petitioner has no grievance left and he

does not wish to pursue with the matter any further and he wants to withdraw the present complaint.

4. In view of the facts stated above, the request of the petitioner to withdraw the case is acceded to and accordingly the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
