## **ORDER**

(Date of Order: 10.05.2016)

- The instant petition has been filed by Sh. Rajinder Singh Ahuja, under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure laid down in Regulations of the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
- 2. The Commission while vide its Interim Order dated 23.12.2015 admitted the petition and directed the Respondent to show cause on the prima facie findings of violations of Regulations 52 (vii) read with Regulation 38(C), 52(ix), Provision to Regulation 52(ix) and 52(x) of Delhi Electricity Supply Code & Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

3. Subsequently, the Respondent vide its letter No. BRPL/CCG/2361 dated 31.03.2016 has submitted that the aforesaid dispute has been settled amicably between both the parties under OTSS (one time settlement scheme) on 29.03.2016 and prayed that the matter may kindly be disposed-

off.

4. The Respondent Company has also forwarded a copy of application dated 29.03.2016 by the petitioner - Sh. Rajinder Singh Ahuja for withdrawal of the Complaint, whereby it has been submitted that the matter have been amicably settled between both the parties and in view of the settlement of the dispute in respect of the captioned matter the complainant wants to withdraw the present complaint.

- 5. In view of the facts stated above, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
