ORDER

(Date of Order: 12.02.2016)

1. The instant petition under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 titled Ms Rashi (Registered consumer) vs. BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. has been filed by through present owner Ms Pinki for violation of the procedure laid down of the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. The Commission while admitting the above petition, vide its Interim Order dated 06.01.2015, directed the Respondent to show cause on the prima facie findings of violations of Regulations 52 (vi), 52(ix), 52(x), and 53(ii) of Delhi Electricity Supply Code & Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

3. The matter was listed for hearing in the Commission on 05.11.2015. During the hearing, the Counsel for the Respondent submitted an affidavit stating that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and furnished a copy of letter of Respondent Company, wherein it was informed that Meter Testing bill of the Complainant has been quashed and consumer/user has willingly agreed to withdraw the case. However, no letter or affidavit from the Complainant was furnished by the Respondent. The Commission directed the Respondent to obtain a copy of settlement letter/Affidavit from the Complainant and to file it before the Commission.
4. Subsequently, a letter dated 17.12.2015 has been received from the Respondent along with a copy of settlement letter dated 15.12.2015 filed by the Petitioner, Ms. Pinki, wherein she has stated that the matter has already been amicably settled between the petitioner and the respondent company and there is no dispute remains in respect of the captioned matter. The petitioner has sought permission of the Commission to withdraw the said Petition.
5. The Commission acceded the request of petitioner and dismissed the petition as settled between the parties.
6. Ordered accordingly.
