<u>ORDER</u>

- 1. Heard Shri Parinay deep Shah, Counsel for the Petitioner. The Petitioner has made the following prayers:
 - a) Direct the Respondent, NDMC to clear the dues and interest owed to the Petitioner arising out of the invoices raised and the remaining portion of the subsidy received from the MNRE by NDMC, cumulatively amounting to Rs. 7,27,89,353/-.
 - b) Initiate appropriate proceeding under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-compliance of direction issued by the Commission.
 - c) Pass any such order or direction as this Learned Commission may deems fit and proper in the interest of justice.
- 2. After hearing Shri Parinay deep Shah for some time, the Commission had put up a query to the Counsel of the Petitioner as to how the Petition is maintainable under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 and whether Section 142 will be an

appropriate and effective remedy for the kind of grievance the Petitioner has raised in the Petition. It is also noteworthy that the Petitioner is already before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in this matter and the Petition is still pending. At this juncture, the Petitioner has submitted that he wants to withdraw the Petition with liberty to take appropriate steps by filing appropriate applications/petition before the appropriate forum.

3. The Petition is accordingly dismissed with the aforesaid liberty.
