Respondent and the electricity to the premises has not been restored till

date.

5. The representative of the Respondent submitted that there were some

technical issues, which have since been resolved and the electricity to the

premises of the petitioner has been restored. The Commission directed

the parties to confirm whether electricity to the premises has been

restored or not. After enquiry, the parties confirmed that the electricity

has been restored.

6. The Commission directed the Respondent to file a joint statement in

respect of settlement on an affidavit within a week. The matter will be

decided on the basis of the affidavit.

7. Ordered accordingly.
